DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER BY PROCLAMATION OF THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WOODBRANCH VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the City of Woodbranch Village on July 8, 2024, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property resulting from:

severe weather from Hurricane Beryl, flooding, damaging winds, and downed trees and power outages

which requires emergency action; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Woodbranch Village has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to prevent and to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property; and,

WHEREAS the City of Woodbranch Village Emergency Management Plan should be activated;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WOODBRANCH, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the City of Woodbranch Village, Texas pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Woodbranch Village, TX.

SECTION 3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

SECTION 4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the city emergency management plan and activates the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration.

SECTION 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
